

94.1 The Sound's Woof in the Workday Contest Rules

These Contest rules are specific to the above Contest conducted by Entercom Washington, LLC d/b/a KSWD (collectively, the “**Station**”). Except to the extent specifically set forth below with respect to this specific Contest, the Station’s general contest rules apply to this Contest as well. A copy of these specific Contest rules and the Station’s general contest rules are available at the Station’s studio at 800 5th Ave Suite 1400 Seattle, WA. 98104 during regular business hours and on the Station’s website at www.941thesoundseattle.com/rules. **To the extent that the general contest rules differ from these rules, these rules will govern and control with respect to this Contest.**

How to Enter

1. No purchase or payment of any kind is necessary to enter or win the Sound’s Woof in the Workday Contest (the “**Contest**”).
2. To enter, from 12:00am (PT) on February 24, 2020 until 11:59pm (PT) on December 24, 2020, go to www.941thesoundseattle.com , click on the Woof in the Workday link and complete the on-line entry form with:
 - a. your contact information (name, address, daytime telephone number, email address)
 - b. The name of your pet.
 - c. Upload a video of your pet barking. Video should not exceed fifteen seconds (longer videos will not be disqualified but Station judges will only view the first fifteen seconds of each entry and only the first fifteen seconds will be posted online, if applicable). The uploaded video must be in one of the following video formats: mov, mp4, mpg, mpeg, wmv.
3. **Only the entrant who is eighteen (18) years of age or older and who is the owner of the pet depicted in the video may enter this Contest.** No other person’s image, voice or talent can be captured in the video. **Any video with any other person(s) than the one (1) pet will be ineligible and will be disqualified. ANY VIDEO THAT CONTAINS ANY MUSIC WHATSOEVER WILL BE IMMEDIATELY DISQUALIFIED. Entrants may not even sing or speak the lyrics to any copyrighted song or any other copyrighted material in their video (no portion of copyrighted poems, etc...) unless the associated copyrights are owned by the entrant and no one else (Station may require proof).**
4. All entrants who submit an entry agree to the following and Station will require, as a condition of entry, that entrants affirmatively check a box or an “I agree” button expressly confirming the following:
 - Entrant represents and warrants that he/she is over 18 years of age and a legal resident of the state(s) of: Washington.
 - Entrant represents and warrants that he/she own the rights to, or have obtained permission to use, the video submitted with the entry.
 - Entrant represents and warrants that there is only one person visible in the attached video and that person is the Entrant.
 - Entrant represents and warrants that he/she authorizes Station to post the video on Station’s website or social network sites or use the video in any other way Station sees fit.

By submitting a video, each Entrant represents and warrants that they own the rights to, or have obtained permission to use, the video submitted with each entry. Further, each Entrant authorizes the Station to post the video on the www.941thesoundseattle.com website or its Facebook page or other social media sites.

6. Video entries must not contain any indecency, profanity or obscenity as determined by Station in its sole discretion. Video entries must not contain or depict any registered trade/servicemark or other copyrighted material other than those owned or licensed by the entrants or the Station or a Contest Sponsor. BY ENTERING THIS CONTEST AND SUBMITTING A VIDEO, THE ENTRANT IS REPRESENTING TO STATION THAT THE USE AND DISTRIBUTION OF SUCH VIDEO WILL NOT VIOLATE OR INFRINGE UPON THE RIGHTS OF ANY THIRD PARTY, INCLUDING, WITHOUT LIMITATION, COPYRIGHTS OF OTHERS. By submitting a video, Entrants agree to indemnify Station should any representations and warranties in these Contest rules prove to be false or inaccurate.

By entering this Contest, Entrants understand and agree that Station may elect to use any entry submitted for entertainment purposes and may choose to comment on, mock, poke fun at, and/or mimic any entry submitted. Winners will be selected subject to eligibility verification and compliance with these Contest rules. Entries not selected as a Winner will be retained and included in all subsequent Winner Selection Dates in the Contest. Each winner will have their name, their pet's name and pet's barking audio announced on-air at approximately 7:50am (PT) on one (1) weekday the following week, as assigned by the Station. Winners will be notified of winning via phone to the phone number entered on their online entry.

Prize(s)

9. One-hundred and twenty (220) **"Prizes"** will be awarded in this Contest. Each Prize is one (1) \$50 gift card



to Pet Pros. All Prizes valued at \$50 and are provided by Pet Pros. Entrants may only win once during the Contest. The cards are not redeemable for cash and Pet Pros is not responsible for lost/stolen cards.

Other Rules Specific to This Contest

11. Station is conducting this Contest using proprietary software owned by a third party known as Second Street Inc. ("Second Street"). Second Street is not a sponsor of this Contest but entrants may be required, as part of the entry process, to agree and consent to Second Street's Terms of Service and Privacy Policy (both of which are available via a link during the Contest entry process) (collectively, the "Second Street Policies") and may be required to register with Second Street.
